Dr Wolfhard Erdlenbruch, born 23rd March 1965 in Duisburg, worked as a medical doctor at the Saarland University Hospital after studying human medicine and gaining his doctorate. Having worked in surgery and internal medicine (including cardiology), he began to specialise in the given disciplines at the Institute for Transfusion Medicine and Haemostaseology at the Saarland University Hospital.

He subsequently moved to the Western Palatinate Hospital (Westpfalz-Klinikum) of Kaiserslautern to become the physician responsible for the coagulation clinic and laboratory. After ten years of active clinic work, Dr Erdlenbruch joined Novo Nordisk Pharma in 2002 to become medical manager for the indication of inherited coagulation disorders. In this position, he was responsible for dealing with Germany, Austria and Switzerland.

In 2008 he assumed the role of medical director at Daiichi Sankyo Deutschland GmbH, which since 2010 has also covered DACH. He is responsible for all medical matters, as well as pharmacovigilance, compliance with drug advertising laws and the professional training and development of company employees. Central to his activities is the conduction of phase IV studies and scientific projects, concentrating on the areas of cardiovascular diseases, anticoagulation and oncology.
