

Cycle of the parasitic infection






Our treatments


Why?

> 900 million people treated, mainly school-aged children




New pediatric treatment option for preschoolers, & new preclinical candidate – March 2025: First preschooler receiving the drug

Achieve interruption of transmission of schistosomiasis




Progress
